ABOUT THE PERSON

QBuild is seeking Electricians with the following skill set:

- Current electrical workers licence
- Current Workplace Health & Safety Blue Card
- Current cardio-pulmonary resuscitation certificate
- Ability to work alone or in a team
- Understands and implements quality control techniques
- Ability to exercise discretion
- Ability to complete paperwork required for engineering projects
- Provides guidance and assistance to tradespersons, apprentices and trainees
- Understanding of AS3000 and electrical safety requirements
- Understanding of asbestos handling requirements

Additional qualifications that will be highly regarded are:

- Cabling certificate (equivalent to ACA or Austel)
- Fibre optics cabling certificate (equivalent to Cat 5)
- Restricted plumbing licence – hot water
- Dual trade qualifications (eg plumbers licence)

General physical capabilities required of this position:

- Wears personal protective equipment eg safety boots, ear protection, goggles, respiratory devices
- Ability to bend, twist, squat and work on uneven/sloping surfaces
- Ability to undertake manual handling within safe lifting limits eg ladders, pipes
- Capable of using hand tools and power tools correctly

Examples of work that may be required are:

- Install, repair, maintain, test, commission and/or fault find in relation to electrical and engineering services
- Work on complex or intricate circuitry involving examining, diagnosing and modifying systems comprising inter-connected circuits

Field Staff Entitlements

GENERAL ENTITLEMENTS FOR FIELD STAFF

Wages

- 38 hour week – working 40 hours a week with an rostered day off (RDO) once a month (generally in accordance with industry RDO calendar)
- Fortnightly wage – paid directly into your nominated bank account
- Superannuation – up to 12.75%
- Nominated fortnightly deductions to institutions of your choice eg union fees, bank accounts, insurances, mortgages

Allowances

- Allowances – a single fortnightly payment (SFP), trade specific, consists of trade based allowances, includes fares/travel and tool allowances.
- Overtime and penalty rates
- Meal allowances
- Working in the rain penalties
- Country work allowance
- Remote area work allowance
- First aid allowance
- Weekend work allowance (fares/travel for working Saturday and Sunday)
- Excess kilometre allowance – for use of own motor vehicle for approved work purposes
- Unpleasant conditions payment
- On-call allowance
- District allowance

Leave

- Recreation leave
 - 20 days + 17.5% leave loading
- Sick leave – 10 days accumulative each year
- Long service leave – 1.3 weeks per year, accessible after 7 years of service, payable after 10 years of service
- Bereavement leave
- Emergent/Compassionate leave – 3 days per year (non-accumulative)
- Special leave
 - Extra leave for proportionate salary
 - Defence Reserve Forces leave
 - Disaster event leave
 - SES member leave
- Maternity and Paternity leave – up to 2 years
- Carers leave
- Meritorious sick leave – after 26 years exemplary service, conditions apply

Other

- Remote area incentives in nominated remote locations
- Housing rental assistance in nominated remote locations
- Transfer and Appointment expenses – includes furniture and vehicle removal, travel expenses for employee and immediate family members (including pets) to the centre of appointment
